To Burleson County MUD #1 Customers

The Board of Directors of Burleson County MUD #1 is writing to provide an update on the status of the water system and upcoming maintenance activities.

Our water system is approximately 25 years old. Until recently, we have not experienced the need for major repairs. We have now had a well pump fail, and it must be replaced. While this work is underway, we will also perform a full inspection of the well liner and complete any necessary cleaning. Based on the inspection results, we will determine what work, if any is required for the remaining three wells.

In addition, we are required this year to conduct a comprehensive inspection of all five water tanks in the water yard.

To help offset increased operating and maintenance expenses, water rates will increase beginning with the May billing cycle (bills printed in May for water used in April). The basic rate will increase to \$55.00 for the first 3,000 gallons for residential meters. Usage above 3,000 gallons will also increase in accordance with the attached rate sheet.

We have worked hard to keep water rates as low as possible; however, as the system ages, maintenance requirements increase, and a portion of these additional costs must be reflected in customer rates.
